BITMAPS - Bitmaps are used in programs such as Photoshop. When a photo is taken with a digital camera the image is captured as a bitmap. Bitmaps allow colors to blend and work best for photos. Crisp lines are lost using bitmap art work unless the bitmap is saved at a high resolution of 300 dpi or above. This loss of crisp lines will effect type, logos and line artwork.

Acceptable Bitmap file types: .bmp, .jpg, .tiff, and Photoshop = .psd

BITMAPS IDENTIFICATION - Save the file to your computer where you can find it. Right click on the file and select "properties". A window will open that will tell you: "File Type" and "File Size". You can also check the dpi of a file by opening it into a program such as Photoshop or most other photo editing software.
